MARCH 5, 2024 PRESIDENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION
Candidate Calendar

September 14, 2023 (E-173)	Signature-in-lieu collection period begins for all candidates.
September 29, 2023 (E-158)	Candidate filing begins for Central Committees.
*October 22, 2023 (E-135)	Political parties must notify the Secretary of State if they will allow cross over voting by this date.
October 30, 2023 (E-127)	First day candidates for judicial offices may file the Declaration of Intention.
November 8, 2023 (E-118)	Last day for judicial candidates to file the Declaration of Intention. This period is extended if the incumbent does not file.
November 8, 2023 (E-118)	Signature-in-lieu collection period closes for all candidates.
November 13, 2023 (E-113)	Close of extended filing period for the Declaration of Intention.
November 13, 2023 (E-113)	Candidate filing begins.
December 8, 2023 (E-88)	Close of regular candidate filing period. Extended candidate filing period begins for some offices.
December 13, 2023 (E-83)	Close of extended candidate filing period.
December 14, 2023 (E-82)	Random alphabet draw to be held at 11 a.m. to determine the ballot order of candidates' names.
January 8, 2024 (E-57)	Write-in candidate filing period begins.
January 25, 2024 (E-40)	County voter information guide may begin to be mailed.
February 5, 2024 (E-29)	Ballots will be mailed to all active registered voters by this date. Ballots can begin being processed.
**February 20, 2024 (E-14)	Last day to register for this election and be mailed voting materials for this election.
February 20, 2024 (E-14)	Write-in candidate filing period ends.
February 21, 2024 (E-13)	First day for conditional registration for this election.
February 27, 2024 (E-7)	Last day to request ballot be mailed – request requires an original signature.
March 5, 2024	ELECTION DAY
