The last day to register to vote for the May 7, 2019 Special District Mail Ballot Election, for Placer Hills Fire Protection District and Foresthill Fire Protection District is April 22, 2019. Registration forms may be picked up at all post offices, libraries, and Department of Motor Vehicles within Placer County or online at [www.registertovote.ca.gov](http://www.registertovote.ca.gov). To further assist Placer County voters, voter registration forms will be placed outside the Placer County Elections Office entrance at 2956 Richardson Drive, in Auburn, on April 22nd until 12:00 AM (midnight). Completed registration forms will be processed the next morning. In addition, completed registration forms can be placed in the secure, drive-up drop-off box located in front of the Elections Office.

The Placer County Elections Office will be open Monday through Friday 8 AM – 5 PM. Elections staff will be available on these days to process ballot requests and issue ballots over the counter. Voters may call 530-886-5650 or toll-free in California at 1-800-824-8683, with questions regarding the upcoming election.

If you have interacted recently with the DMV, your voter registration information may have been changed. It is important to confirm your voter status; political party preference, vote by mail status, address and all other pertinent information to make sure you are still registered correctly. Check your status at [votestatus.sos.ca.gov](http://votestatus.sos.ca.gov).

Voters who miss the registration deadline may come to the Elections Office, during normal business hours and complete a Conditional Voter Registration.
